which seeks to increase Vietnam's electricity load by 9.84 percent from 2021 to 2025, and 8.88 percent from 2026 to 2030.

This growth calculation is based on a projected annual GDP growth of 7.5 percent in the first half of the decade and 7.2 percent in the second half.

Under the plan, thermal power will remain the largest source of energy for Vietnam by 2030, followed by hydropower and LNG power.
