Vũ Văn Bằng, general director of DAP Vinachem, hopes that the Government will maintain and not increase the export tax on fertilisers in groups 31.02, 31.03, 31.04, 31.05 in the Export Tariff. The consumption of this company's products in the domestic market was currently the highest at only 49 per cent of its designed capacity, which forces the company to export, said Bang. If the tax is increased to limit fertiliser exports, the production cost of DAP fertiliser would certainly rise due to inventory, he added./.
