

LAM DONG PROVINCE

Lam Dong province is a province located in the Central Highlands (Tây Nguyên) region of Vietnam. Its capital is Đà Lạt. Lâm Đồng borders Khánh Hòa Province and Ninh Thuận Province to the east, Đồng Nai Province to the southwest, Bình Thuận Province to the southeast, Đắk Lắk Province to the north, and Đắk Nông Province to the northwest.

It has an area of 9,765 km² and a population of over 1.5 million people. Thanks to 4 Universities (Da Lat University, Yersin University, Architecture University and Ton Duc Thang University), its labor force is among the highest ranking in grey matter in Vietnam. With diversified natural resources of land, forest, mountains, minerals, etc, Lam Dong province has favorable conditions for development of agriculture, forestry, tourism, industry and services.

Lam Dong province is easily accessible through Da Lat airport, national railways and major highways. It is also conveniently connected with key economic regions in the South region like Hochiminh City (293km), Binh Duong (271km), Dong Nai (148km)... There are daily flights to Ho Chi Minh City, Hanoi, Da Nang, and to a number international cities (Bangkok, Seoul, Kuala Lumpur...). Transportation of merchandise via road from Đà Lạt to Cam Ranh port- Khánh Hòa about 100km; to Tân Cảng- Cái Mép port about 300km.

BINH THUAN PROVINCE

Binh Thuan Province is situated in the South Central Region and the gateway of the Southern Key Economic Zone with the Central and Central Highlands. Its capital is Phan Thiet. Binh Thuan borders Ninh Thuan Province to the North, Lam Dong Province to the Northwest, Dong Nai Province to the West, Ba Ria – Vung Tau Province to the Southwest, adjacent to the Bien Dong sea to the East and the South with the coastline of 192 km long and has area adjacent to international maritime routes.

It has an area of 7.813 km² and a population of over 1.3 million people. Thanks to 1 University, 3 Colleges, 1 professional intermediate school, 15 vocational training centers and 9 non-public vocational training institutions. Vocational training institutions are capable of providing skills labor force, training and supplying human resources for business in the province and the region. With a mild climate, it has many potentials of marine resources, forestry, agriculture, minerals, oil and tourism.

Binh Thuan province has Vinh Tan International Port with the ability to accommodate 50.000 DWT bulk ships has been in operation. The North – South expressway, with is expected to be completed in 2023, will connect Binh Thuan with the Southern key Economic Region, contribute to significantly improving the logistics service system and create a driving force for sustainable development.

NINH THUAN PROVINCE

Ninh Thuan is a province in the South Central Coast region of Vietnam, borders Khanh Hoa in the North, Binh Thuan in the South, Lam Dong in the West, East Sea in the East. It is located on T-junction connecting South - Eastern key economic zone with South Central Region and Central Highlands; about 60km from Cam Ranh International Airport, 40km from Cam Ranh Seaport (capable of receiving ships of 50,000 tons) and 350km from Ho Chi Minh City. Ninh Thuan has multiple axes of traffic connecting with Central Highlands and the whole country (National Road 1, 27, HCM City - Nha Trang express railway, etc); the 105.8 km long coastal road from Binh Tien to Ca Na.

It has an area of 3,358 km² and a population of 590,467 people, of which 343.7 thousand people (58.2%) are in the labour force. According to the Resolution 115/NQ-CP by the Government, Ninh Thuan has focused on being a hub for clean energy production of Vietnam. Many national-level projects are going to be implemented in the upcoming time: Ca Na International cargo port (can receive the ships above 300,000 tons), National high-speed railways, upgrading Da Lat - Thap Chap railway, national tourist resorts, gas-fired power projects, energy projects...

The 6 priority development sectors of Ninh Thuan: (1) energy, (2) tourism, (3) agriculture, forestry & seafood, (4) industry, (5) education-training and (6) construction & real estate.
